## Improvements to the accessibility of the San Miguel Cemetery, with reforms inside also.

The Nerja City Council, has built a new ramp and an access door to the San Miguel Municipal Cemetery on Velázquez street and has carried out reforms inside with an investment of 8,000 euros.

## The construction works of 11 VPO homes for young people in Nerja.

11 subsidized VPO housing for rent for young people that are being built on Zurbarán street, Nerja with an investment of 1.4 million euros, co-financed by the City Council and the Government of Spain, through the Junta de Andalucía. The 11 homes will be distributed in a building with a ground floor and first floor, which is currently under construction. They will have a living room, kitchen, bathroom and 2 or 3 bedrooms. In addition, a basement floor has been built that will have parking spaces and storage rooms.

## Complete reform of two tennis courts at the Los Llanos Sports Complex.

A councillor from Torrox has highlighted the efforts of the current government team to expand and improve the sports facilities of the municipality. Seeing the evolution of the Los Llanos sports complex in recent years is a clear example of this.

For his part, the Councillor for Sports explained that the comprehensive reform of tennis courts 1 and 2 of the complex has consisted of replacing the porous floor with another made of resin and the repair of all the perimeter fencing of both courts



## Andalucia rape cases soared during 2022.

Reported rape cases rose by 46.5 per cent in 2022 in Andalucía compared to 2019, according to the Ministry of the Interior's crime report. Rape figures in Andalucía between 2019 and 2022 are lower than the national average, which stands at 53.2 per cent.

start feeding when new green growth appears and hopefully it will grow on into another season. The pine trees on the waste ground at the bottom of our garden have had a few of the nests of the dreaded processional caterpillars. We have been advised to kill them off as quickly as possible, as they can be fatal to cats and dogs if touched.

In the campo the farmers shoot the nests out of the trees, an easier way is to carefully pull the nest down and burn it. This we have done and the other inaccessible ones we are leaving to the Hoopoe birds to eat. We discovered last year that this bird likes the taste, so hopefully they will finish them off for us!

Our regular gardening column by Irene Beenham. Throughout the year, Irene describes the range of emotions experienced in creating her very own 'Spanish Garden', offering help and advice along the way.

I did my first propagation by the layering technique at the beginning of the month. The plant was Honeysuckle and all but one, of the cutting have rooted. One of the nice things about Honeysuckle is that it is an evergreen, so there is a year round interest as well as that lovely sweet scented blossom. I was going to repaint the walls white around part of the garden where I planned to plant the new climbers. Fortunately, I mentioned this to these wise gardening friends of ours and they advised me not to paint.

Their experience has shown that climbing plants don't grow well or not at all up new paint. Any planting should only be done after about 6 months. Too long for me!

So, as the idea is to cover the wall with leaf and colour, why go to the trouble? Hurray! Painting walls white is not my idea of fun and less to do better. Ther local irrigation system is currently being piped ready for metering. When the water ran down the channel behind our garden wall, some used to flow into our little pond and keep it topped up and fresh. Now that doesn't happen, I am having to make sure that it doesn't become a breeding ground for mosquitos.

What you have to do is pour a little cooking oil, like sunflower, onto the surface of the water. The mosquito larvae, after hatching live suspended in the water just under the surface. Adding the oil apparently stops them breathing and they die off. More words of wisdom passed on to me. I guess what I really need is the mosquito fish which I first heard about from a gardening program on one of the local radio stations the other day. This fish lives in tanks, as well as pools and eats mosquito larvae. I have always liked the idea of a pond with fish, plants and a fountain. We have a small plunge pool, but our grandchildren prefer the big pool as they swim well.

When the gravel garden is finished, I shall start putting together some ideas for a pond.

## DOG SCHOOL - NERJA Pine Processionary Caterpillars



Between the months of February and April, you need to be aware of the Pine Processionary Caterpillar (Thaumetopoea Pityocampa). Unlike the vast majority of caterpillars, this particular species can be harmful to young children and sometimes fatal to dogs and cats. They burrow below ground to pupate into adult months and the drought over the last 12 months has made it more difficult for them to do this because the ground is too hard, and it's meant that they aren't as prolific this year as they normally are, but they are still around. You can spot their nests in the trees quite easily as they look like white cotton wool like balls high in the trees. Many dog owners have lost their pets after coming into contact with the caterpillars so you must be familiar with them and the potential dangers. In early spring, the processionary caterpillars leave their nests high up in the pine trees and head to the ground to pupate. When this happens, they potentially come into contact with young children and curious pets.

## What is a Processionary Caterpillar?

The processionary caterpillar is mostly found in wooded forests and can be identified by the thousands of small fine poisonous hairs or bristles that cover their bodies.

The caterpillars are 3-4cm in length and are usually an orange and brown colour.

The name 'processionary' comes from the fact that they create a procession from head to tail to form a long chain. It is not unheard of to see chains with hundreds of them all joined together. When the larvae are ready to pupate at this time of year, they will march single file down the tree to the ground where they disperse looking for somewhere to continue their life cycle, often burrowing just below the surface.

The barbed hairs on their bodies are often fatal to dogs who either decide to eat one of the insects or sniff the hairs which can also be propelled by the caterpillar in an attempt to protect itself. The hairs or bristles contain an type of protein called Thaumetopoein which can in minor cases cause skin irritation or a rash much like that experienced after rubbing a stinging nettle. An antihistamine cream will usually be enough to alleviate the symptoms. In more severe cases, humans can experience allergic reactions or respiratory problems. Asthmatics are particularly vulnerable and at risk of having a severe attack. If you walk your dog in wooded areas, it is advisable to keep them on a tight lead at all times to make sure they don't

come into contact with the insects.

#### If you do find a nest do not touch it! Contact the local authorities or specialists straight away so they can remove it safely.

Even if the nest is empty, the hairs from the caterpillars may still be present so still pose a danger to health. If the nests are not removed by a professional the hairs may become airborne causing further issues. Make sure your neighbours are aware of the danger, especially those who may have young children, dogs or other pets.

## What to Do if Your Pet Comes Into Contact With Them

If a dog or other pet comes into contact with processionary caterpillars, they may have small white spots around their mouth or on their tongue. As the rash develops, this can lead to drooling and may cause your pet to become distressed. The tongue may also swell and lead to vomiting and potential suffocation. If you believe your pet has come into contact with them, you should wash their mouth with warm water. It is advisable to wear gloves so you also do not get infected. It is then essential that you take them to a vet immediately. Do not delay! The vet will most likely administer a fast-acting cortisone injection to reduce the swelling and irritation. They may be kept overnight for observation.

# Determining and proving domicile

Domicile is an important issue for British expatriates. You remain liable to UK inheritance tax on your worldwide assets for as long as you are domiciled in the UK. While it can be possible to change your domicile, it depends on your circumstances and intentions and should be a carefully considered and planned process.

The basic rule is that a person is domiciled in the country in which they have their home permanently or indefinitely – the country you regard as your homeland, 'the place where you intend to die'.

You can live in Spain for years and remain domiciled in the UK.

#### Domicile and inheritance tax

Whether or not your estate will be assessed for UK inheritance tax (IHT) depends on your domicile status (not tax residence).

Anyone deemed UK-domiciled is liable to 40% inheritance tax on their worldwide assets. Each individual has a £325,000nil rate band plus a £175,000 'family home allowance' if they meet certain conditions. Any balance not used when the first spouse/civil partner dies can be passed to the survivor.

Assets inherited by one spouse/partner from another are generally not liable for IHT – but. if one of you is a non-UK domicile, there may be some inheritance tax to pay so take personalised advice.

UK situated assets are always liable to IHT regardless of domicile.

#### Types of domicile

Domicile of origin – UK common law ascribes a domicile of origin to every individual at birth. Generally the father's domicile, or the mother's if single (not necessarily your country of birth).

Domicile of dependence – applies to women married before 1974, minors and other legal dependents. Domicile of choice – As the HM Revenue & Customs RDRM22010 explains, "any individual who has legal capacity can acquire a domicile of choice".

#### Acquiring a domicile of choice

To acquire a domicile of choice you must be physically present and tax resident in your new country and intend to live there permanently or indefinitely.

Since HMRC could look for indications you see Britain as your homeland and may return in future, you need to sever as many ties as possible. Electing for UK succession law to apply over Spanish succession rules could also be a tipping point combined with other UK ties.

Even if you take all the steps to adopt a domicile of choice

outside UK, it can take up to four years to shed a UK domicile for inheritance tax purposes. HMRC may treat you as UK-domiciled if you:

1. were UK resident for 15 of the last 20 tax years

2. return to Britain for over a year (if UK is your domicile of origin and place of birth)

3. move to a third country - until you can demonstrate you have established a new domicile of choice.

#### **Proving domicile**

Domicile determination is a highly specialist area; you need professional advice to ensure you get it right

If you believe you have shaken off your UK domicile but HMRC determine otherwise, your heirs will face an unexpected tax bill.

Here are examples of types of information HMRC could request during a domicile enquiry:

• Date, place and nationality at birth, parents' names and marital status, details of siblings.

• Marriages/civil partnerships details, divorce, long-term cohabitation, children's details (names, dates of birth, nationalities, education, current locations etc),

## THE DRUMMONDS AND THEIR ROYAL CONNECTION

I was interested to read Part One of Dupes and Duplicity in the January issue of Streetwise; not because I'm interested in the 18th century's greatest femme fatal, but because Drummond's bank is mentioned. At the time I just happened to have a friend staying with me who is descended from the Drummonds. She laughed when she read that Henry Drummond had refused to give a loan. None of her family members could ever get a loan from Drummond's bank! Drummond's bank was founded in 1717 and was used by King George III after he was displeased with Coutts bank for bankrolling the Prince of Wales from his own personal account. Drummond's bank honored his wishes but when he died, the Prince of Wales moved his account back to Coutts. Queen Elizabeth the Queen Mother banked with Drummond's bank until it was bought by the Royal Bank of Scotland

The Drummonds have an interesting history because it was a Drummond who married the grand-daughter of an illegitimate son of King Charles II and his mistress Nell Gwyn. This son, called Charles after his father, was born in May 1670 but was not given the surname FitzRoy, usually given to the illegitimate children of the King. Nell Gwyn wanted her children to be elevated to a peerage and by 1676 Charles had become the Earl of Burford and Baron Heddington. A month later Charles and his younger brother James were given the surname Beauclerk and granted their own Coat of Arms.

In 1683 Charles Beauclerk was elevated to a peerage, given the title Duke of St. Albans, and moved into the palace to begin his life as a courtier. He enjoyed a generous allowance from his father of £1500 a year, increasing with each title and honour bestowed upon him. Just before Charles II died he was granted the office of the Master of the King's Hawks and Grand Falconer of England, with an additional income of £1500 a year, a nod to his mother's love of hawking. These titles are still held by the Duke of St. Albans today. At a young age Charles identified as the son of the King and often travelled with his father. His brother James was more of a mother's boy, had health problems, and died at the age of eight.

When Charles was seventeen he travelled abroad to supposedly become a Catholic, in accordance with James II's wishes, but instead he went to the Dutch Republic to support William of Orange's claim to the English throne. After this his military career took off in the imperial army and he served under William III in Flanders. He remained popular with William III and in 1695 was granted a pension of £2000 a year from the Crown. His Whig sentiments prevented an advancement under Queen Anne, but he was restored to favour at the accession of George I who made him a Knight of the Garter.

In 1694 he married the celebrated beauty and heiress, Diana de Vere, daughter of the 20th Earl of Oxford, a noble family going back 150 years. They had nine sons and three daughters, and it was the daughter of their son William who married a Drummond. Charles Beauclerk died in 1726 and was buried in Westminster Abbey.

Charlotte, daughter of William Beauclerk, married John Drummond, the son of Andrew Drummond who founded Drummond's bank. They had two sons, George and John, and it is from this side of the family that my friend is descended. On a copy of the family tree, easily accessed via Google, only my friend's brother is shown. His claim to fame is that his illegitimate son is married to Claudia Scheffer! History repeating itself?

## Easter Bread

Serves:- 10 to 12

#### Ingredients:-

1/4 c. warm water (about 110°)
1 tbsp. active dry yeast (from 2 1/4-oz. packets)
3/4 c. warm milk (about 110°)
1/2 c. granulated sugar
6 tbsp. unsalted butter, melted
3 large eggs, divided
4 1/2 c. all-purpose flour, plus more for the surface
2 1/2 tsp. salt
Nonstick cooking spray
4 dyed uncooked eggs, at room temperature (optional)
1 c. powdered sugar
2 tbsp. whole milk
Rainbow sprinkles, for garnish (optional)

#### **Preparation:-**

Stir together the water and the yeast in a small bowl. Let the mixture stand until it is foamy, about 5 minutes. Combine the yeast mixture, milk, sugar, butter, and 2 of the eggs, beaten, in the bowl of a stand mixer fitted with a



dough hook. Beat on medium-low speed until combined, about 30 seconds. Add the flour and salt and mix with a spatula until a shaggy dough forms. Return the bowl to the mixer; increase the speed to medium and beat until the dough is smooth, elastic and tacky, about 5 minutes. Transfer the dough to a large bowl lightly greased with non stick cooking spray. Cover the bowl with plastic wrap and let the dough rise at warm room temperature until the dough is doubled in size, 1 to 1 1/2 hours.

Turn the dough out onto a lightly floured surface and divide it into 3 equal portions (about 12 ounces each). Roll each of the portions into an 18 to 20 inch long rope. Braid the ropes together, pinching the ends to seal and tucking them underneath. Transfer the braid to a parchment-lined baking sheet. If desired, tuck dyed eggs into the braid, spacing them evenly apart. Cover the loaf loosely with plastic wrap and let it rise at warm room temperature until it has puffed, 30 to 45 minutes.

During the last 30 minutes of proofing, preheat the oven to 350°. Uncover the loaf and brush it lightly with the remaining beaten egg. Bake the loaf until it is golden brown, 28 to 32 minutes. Slide the loaf and the parchment paper onto a wire rack to cool completely, about 1 1/2 hours.

Whisk together the powdered sugar and the milk until smooth in a medium bowl. (Add a touch more milk, if needed). Drizzle the glaze over the cooled loaf and decorate with sprinkles, if you like.

## Whipped Deviled Eggs with Dill

#### Serves:-8 to 10

#### Ingredients:-

- 10 large eggs
- 6 tbsp. heavy cream
- 1 heaping tablespoon dijon mustard
- 1 tsp. white vinegar
- Kosher salt and black pepper, to taste

1 tbsp. finely chopped dill, plus small sprigs for topping

#### Preparation:-

Fill a large pot halfway with water, then bring the water to a boil. Use a slotted spoon to gently lower the eggs into the boiling water. Cover the pot, reduce the heat and let the eggs simmer for 10 minutes. Remove the eggs from the water and run under cold water until completely cooled.

Peel the eggs and slice in half lengthwise. Scoop out the yolks into the bowl of an electric mixer. Add the heavy cream, mustard and vinegar and season with salt and pepper. Whip the mixture together until light and fluffy, scraping the sides once halfway through.

Fold in the dill. Scrape the mixture into a resealable plastic bag or piping bag and snip off a corner. Pipe into each egg white half. Top with dill sprigs.

## **Hot Cross Buns**

#### Serves:-18

#### Ingredients:-

(For the buns) 2 c. whole milk 1/2 c. canola oil 1/2 c. sugar 1 package (2 1/4 teaspoons) active dry yeast 4 1/2 c. all-purpose flour 1/2 tsp. (heaping) baking powder 1/2 tsp. (scant) baking soda 2 tsp. salt 1/4 c. sugar 1 tsp. cinnamon Spices: Cardamom, nutmeg, allspice (optional) 1/2 c. raisins Cooking spray 1 egg white Splash of milk (For the icing) 1 egg white Powdered sugar Splash of milk

#### Preparation:-

For the buns: Combine 2 cups milk, canola oil, and 1/2 cup sugar in a saucepan. Stir and heat until very warm but not boiling. Turn off the heat and allow to cool until mixture is still warm, but not hot, about 30 minutes. Sprinkle the yeast over the milk mixture. Add 4 cups of flour and stir to combine. The mixture will be very sticky. Cover with a towel and set aside for 1 hour. Add the remaining 1/2 cup flour, baking powder, baking soda, and salt. Fold together to combine. At this point, you can cover tightly and store the dough in the fridge overnight or continue on with making the buns. Combine 1/4 cup sugar with the cinnamon and whatever other spices you want to use.

On a lightly floured surface, stretch and press the dough to slightly flatten. Sprinkle with a couple of tablespoons of the

sugar/cinnamon mixture. Sprinkle on about a third of the raisins. Then fold the dough over on itself and flatten so the dough is "plain" again. Repeat the sugar/raisin process, then fold and flatten the dough again. Repeat a third time until all the raisins are used. (You won't use all the sugar/ cinnamon mixture.) Fold the dough one last time. Pinch off golf ball-sized bunches of dough. With floured hands, quickly roll the dough into a ball, then turn the edges under themselves slightly. Place on a lightly greased cookie sheet. Cover and allow to rise in a warm place for at least 30 minutes...an hour-plus is better.

Preheat the oven to 400°. Mix 1 egg white with a splash of milk. Brush onto each roll. Bake for 20 minutes, give or take, or until tops of buns have turned nice and golden brown. Remove from the pan and allow to cool on a cooling rack.

**For the icing:** Mix 1 egg white with enough powdered sugar for the icing to be very thick. Add a splash of milk, as needed, for consistency. When the rolls are completely cooled, add the icing to a small plastic bag and snip the corner. Make a cross on each roll with the icing. Happy Easter!

physically and/or emotionally harmful situation that has been maintained for a long period of time without being resolved. This situation, sustained over time, is capable of exhausting the strongest person, and the body's natural way of encouraging change is expressed through pictures of stress, anxiety, insomnia, anguish, panic,... Acupuncture allows a reflex effect, through certain points located along the meridians of the body, helping to regulate those organic, nervous or hormonal functions that, due to tension, stress, emotions, rhythm of life, etc. They are unbalanced and cause the symptoms detailed above. The European Foundation for Traditional Chinese Medicine, among other sources, relates the good results

obtained because acupuncture acts on the limbic system. Which is the part of our brain responsible for regulating the physiological and emotional responses of our body.

#### Frequently asked questions:

Benefits of acupuncture for anxiety. Improved rest and sleep quality, and with it the general state of mind. Suffering fewer moments of suffocation or sudden tachycardia, reducing phobias and compulsive actions (anxiety to eat), tension pain and neuralgia, especially those caused by bruxism. How many acupuncture sessions are necessary for anxiety?

From the first sessions you can see a significant reduction in the nervous state; and the usual thing is that after 5 sessions a considerable improvement is noted in the rest of the associated symptoms. Similarly, the precise number of sessions varies depending on the person and how long they have been suffering from anxiety.

How often should I do acupuncture? The first 3/4 sessions it is advisable to do them weekly. Once these have been completed, the second block can be proposed on a fortnightly or monthly basis. Although, depending on the case, it is possible to increase the effect of the treatment in consultation with complementary techniques such as auriculotherapy, phytotherapy or relaxation, extending the space between sessions.

Does acupuncture work for anxiety about eating? As we indicated previously, acupuncture is ideal to help in states of restlessness, which each person expresses in a different way, from generalized anxiety and nervousness, to insomnia or anxiety about eating or smoking.

### How is the acupuncture treatment for anxiety?

The goal of our therapists is always to seek increased wellbeing from the first visit. Therefore, during the first part of the session, the acupuncturist will collect the necessary information through a short interview, listening and observing the person.

With the above information you will be able to evaluate and propose the first treatment in consultation (second part of the session), always painless and aimed at seeing the person's response to acupuncture stimuli.

To end the session, he will listen to how the person has felt, and explain her point of view; proposing a possible treatment, or directing her towards other therapeutic lines, if

she considers that they could be more effective. As a curiosity, let us show you how acupuncture can help you, what is the traditional explanation of Traditional Chinese Medicine for anxiety and give you some examples of its causes according to the "philosophy and through the traditional language" of TCM:

1. Disharmony between Heart and Kidney.

The kidney is not in harmony with the heart and liver. In a first phase, it will manifest with oppression and a sensation of fullness in the chest, pain in the heart area, tachycardia, confused mind, red eyes, heaviness in the head. If you do not intervene, you enter the second phase, characterized by diffuse bone pain, psychological exhaustion, frigidity or impotence, loss of sexual desire, heavy legs and swollen ankles. The symptoms are: physical fatigue, feeling of emptiness, weak breathing and voice, facial paleness, brittle hair, frequent colds, sadness. There are also signs of excess in the liver, which the lungs could not contain: muscle contractions, sudden rages and dizziness. Chinese herbal medicine, acupuncture and moxa are effective remedies to treat it.

#### 3. Hepatic spillover.

Bellicose, aggressive, bold and courageous temperaments are the expression of liver strength. However, discontent, irritation and anger, experienced for a long time, harm it, and anxiety is characterized by a state of general nervous tension, irritability, insomnia, intermittent headaches, flushed face, ringing in the ears, arterial hypertension. Chinese medicine is useful to calm the liver, it should be treated with medicinal plants, acupuncture, moxa and massage. 4. Spleen and Stomach Insufficiency.

The stomach receives and breaks down food; the spleen directs its transformation and distribution. This type of anxiety is due to excessive worry, incessant mental brooding, diets too high in fat or raw vegetables. The symptoms also manifest deficiencies in many other organs: anguish due to kidney failure, amnesia due to heart failure, depression and irritability due to liver failure, loss of appetite, fatigue and a swollen belly after eating. The therapeutic principle is to strengthen the spleen and stomach.

## Walking for good health



Walking for 30 minutes a day or more on most days of the week is a great way to improve or maintain your overall health.

If you can't manage 30 minutes a day, remember even short walks more frequently can be beneficial. Walking with others can turn exercise into an enjoyable social occasion.

#### About walking

Walking is a great way to improve or maintain your overall health. Just 30 minutes every day can increase cardiovascular fitness, strengthen bones, reduce excess body fat, and boost muscle power and endurance. It can also reduce your risk of developing conditions such as heart disease, type 2 diabetes, osteoporosis and some cancers. Unlike some other forms of exercise, walking is free and doesn't require any special equipment or training. Physical activity does not have to be vigorous or done for long periods in order to improve your health.

Walking is low impact, requires minimal equipment, can be done at any time of day and can be performed at your own pace. You can get out and walk without worrying about the risks associated with some more vigorous forms of exercise. Walking is also a great form of physical activity for people who are overweight, elderly, or who haven't exercised in a long time. Walking for fun and fitness isn't limited to strolling by yourself around local neighbourhood streets. There are various clubs, venues and strategies you can use to make walking an enjoyable and social part of your lifestyle.

## Health benefits of walking

You carry your own body weight when you walk. This is known as weight-bearing exercise. Some of the benefits include:-1. Increased cardiovascular and pulmonary (heart and lung) fitness.

2. Reduced risk of heart disease and stroke.

3. Improved management of conditions such as hypertension (high blood pressure), high cholesterol, joint and muscular pain or stiffness, and diabetes

- 4. Stronger bones and improved balance.
- 5. Increased muscle strength and endurance.
- 6. Reduced body fat.

#### Walk for 30 minutes a day

To get the health benefits, try to walk for at least 30 minutes as briskly as you can on most days of the week. 'Brisk' means you can still talk but not sing, and you may be puffing

slightly. Moderate activities such as walking pose little health risk but if you have a medical condition, check with your doctor before starting any new exercise program of physical activity.
#### "Tobacco, tobacco. Sing sweetly for tobacco. Tobacco is like love"

#### Clinica Santa Cecilia

Those words, from a 16th century song, kept repeating in my head recently as I conducted medical revisions on Spanish construction workers. Considering the historical connection Spain has with tobacco - after all, it brought tobacco to Europe 500 years ago and the first cigarette factory was opened in Sevilla in 1620. I should not have been surprised that 70% of my construction worker patients smoked. Still, no matter how deeply ingrained tobacco is in Spanish history, culture and habits, it was my responsibility to challenge their smoking addiction. So, what can I tell a smoker that can help them guit? With giant black letters marking each pack of cigarettes with phrases like "Smoking Kills", they already get the point that smoking is bad for them. So, why don't they quit? Because smoking makes them feel good. Make that really, really good. Within eight seconds, after a drag off a cigarette, nicotine starts a chemical cascade of neurotransmitters- brain chemicals - that flood over the brain's pleasure centres. The brain starts working better with nicotine; improving memory, concentration, reaction time. Nicotine works to convince the brain that it is as needed for survival as food, sex and water, which explains why it is a very powerfully addictive substance. So, how can a smoker quit?

While making the decision to stop smoking is important, don't rely on willpower alone. There are several evidencebased options out there to make quitting a lot easier. Nicotine replacements, such as gums, lozenges or patches, work well for many people and are safe. It is the burnt carcinogens in tobacco that are harmful not the nicotine. Using two different types of nicotine



replacements, like a patch and the gum, at the same time can work better for some people than using only one. There are new pharmacological treatments like bupropion, which changes the way your body responds to nicotine, and varenicline, which bonds to the nicotine receptors in your brain thus reducing your cravings for a cigarette. Combining some good behaviour therapy to help unlearn the habits and rituals that go along with smoking will increase chances for success. Counselling really helps to cope without nicotine and to learn to recognise the cues that provoke that cigarette urge. While current smoking restrictions protect non smokers from second hand

smoke, these restriction have turned smokers into a new type of "social pariah". My construction worker patients told me that they started smoking when they were teenagers. They could not have possibly known that their brains would get rewired in a way that would make them lifetime slaves to the habit. These patients need sympathy and understanding that smoking is something extremely hard to give up. Fortunately, there are these new treatments and medications to give them the support they need.

If you want to stop smoking, work with your physician to come up with a tailor made plan for you.

#### Build physical activity into your life

If it's too difficult to walk for 30 minutes at one time, do regular small bouts (10 minutes) 3 times per day and gradually build up to longer sessions. If your goal is to lose weight, you will need to do physical activity for longer than 30 minutes each day. You can achieve this by starting with smaller bouts of activity throughout the day and increasing these as your fitness improves. Physical activity built into a daily lifestyle plan is also one of the most effective ways to assist with weight loss and keep weight off once it's lost.

Some suggestions to build walking into your daily routine include:-

1. Take the stairs instead of the lift (for at least part of the way).

2. Get off public transport one stop earlier and walk to work or home. 3.

Walk (don't drive) to the local shops.

4. Walk the dog (or your neighbour's dog).

#### Make walking part of your routine

Try to make walking a routine – for example, try to walk at the same time each day.

Remember, you use the same amount of energy no matter what time of day you walk, so do what is most convenient for you.

You may find that asking someone to walk with you will help make it a regular activity. Some people find that keeping an activity diary or log also makes it easier.

#### Wear a pedometer while walking

A pedometer measures the number of steps you take. You can measure your movement throughout a day and compare it to other days or recommended amounts. This may motivate you to move more. The recommended number of steps accumulated per day to achieve health benefits is 10,000 steps or more.

#### A comfortable intensity for walking

For most people, there is little difference in the amount of energy used by walking a kilometre or running a kilometre – it's just that walking takes longer. Plan to cover a set distance each day and monitor how long it takes you to walk this distance. As your fitness improves, you will be able to walk a longer distance and use more energy. Walking fast burns more kilojoules per hour than walking slowly, but this doesn't mean you have to push yourself until you're breathless. Instead, pace yourself so that you can still talk. This simple rule of thumb means that you walk safely within your target heart rate, which brings about health gains.

Our bodies tend to get used to physical activity, so continue to increase your intensity as you improve your fitness levels. You can increase the intensity of your walks by:-

- 1. walking up hills.
- 2. walking with hand weights.

3. increasing your walking speed gradually by including some quick walking.

4. increasing the distance you walk quickly before returning

- to a moderate walking pace.
- 5. walking for longer.

Easter is here and the yearly influx of visitors and guests has begun. Plus, Spring has most definitely arrived on the Costa del Sol. Meaning plenty of blue skies and warm weather, perfect for family gettogethers, barbeques on the beach, and socialising with neighbours and friends.

What is a happy time for most, can instil dread in others. Whilst the children are busy hunting chocolate eggs, the adults can get stuck into the booze. Or is that just you? Do you find every social event is an excuse for a drink? Does it feel like all celebrations end with a hangover? Maybe you have humiliated yourself, or your partner with your drunken behaviour, possibly more than once. Perhaps this has stopped you seeing friends completely, deciding it is just easier to sit at home and drink alone. It feels like there are less people to offend there, and noone is commenting on how much, or how often you are drinking.

Does any of this ring a bell with you? Can you see yourself in this picture? Has your drinking become an issue for you, or those around you? Is your life, and your drinking, out of control and unmanageable? Are you feeling isolated and lonely because of your alcohol use? You are not alone. Millions of people worldwide have admitted defeat in their quest to try and control, or manage, their problem drinking. They found a solution that works; Alcoholics Anonymous (AA) - a 12 Step, peer-support fellowship group.

Here two members of AA talk about how their drinking led them to ask for help.

"My name is Ava. I was a binge drinker. I always knew there was a problem with the way I drank, other people didn't hide their drinking. I did. Other people could stop once they started, I couldn't. I was in denial. I was able to give up alcohol for short periods of time, so I kidded myself, that I was in control.

There was no single occasion that I would count as my rock bottom. It was more a feeling of being totally broken and hating myself. I was sick to death of the lies. I had no self-respect. The unmanageability of my life was getting worse, I knew I needed help.

I went along to my first meeting. Everyone was brighteyed and they were laughing, I wanted some of what they had. Then the sharing started, it was so honest, so open....and listening I knew I was amongst people who understood me."

"My name is Terry. My drinking really took off in my late 20s, when I partied constantly. I was aware of the quantities I was drinking; but I didn't understand what the consequences would be, or how fast my alcoholism was developing.

I couldn't accept the feelings I was experiencing; my self-worth was low; and my dignity was damaged. I would wake most mornings and try to piece together what had happened the night before, call friends to fill in the gaps, and try and laugh it off. But really, I was heading down a very dangerous path. I called the AA helpline and there was a calmly spoken

gentleman on the other end. He told me he would take me along to a meeting of AA, which he did. All I really remember from that first meeting (I was so hungover and ill), is introducing myself and having people help me. I spoke (which was hard as my voice was shaking) and I asked for help. I was so overwhelmed with the kindness given to me and the complete lack of judgement.

To anyone struggling, it is up to you to decide your path. I can wholeheartedly recommend AA. Try a few meetings. It worked for me; it really did give me my life back."

Are the consequences of your alcohol use getting too much? Is alcohol costing you more than money? If you are ready to stop drinking, or want support to help you try, then don't wait until it gets any worse, get in touch.

There are meetings of Alcoholics Anonymous, with friendly people who understand, held daily throughout the Costa del Sol. Meetings are free to attend, and anyone who thinks they may have a problem with alcohol is welcome.

Frida Kahlo (1907-1954) and Diego Rivera (1886-1957) have iconic status in Mexico. The Mexican Revolution of 1910 swept away the old regime and banished European influence in the arts. Kahlo and Rivera, in their different ways, helped to shape the cultural identity of twentieth-century Mexico. Together they made Mexico a magnet for the rest of the world.

The Mexican mural movement, born during the 1920s, was destined to produce some of the greatest public art of the last century. Diego Rivera's panoramic images adorn the walls of public buildings, combining social criticism with a faith in human progress. Inspired by early Italian fresco painting, as well as by Aztec and Maya imagery, his intricate visual narratives incorporate allegory and symbolism. Compared with the monumental scale of Rivera's work, Kahlo's work is small in format. Arguably Mexico's most original painter, she made herself the principal theme of her art. Her paintings reflect her experiences, dreams, hopes and fears.

In 2005 an estimated 340,000 visitors saw her retrospective at Tate Modern. Photographs of Frida were simultaneously exhibited at the National Portrait Gallery under the title Frida Kahlo: Portraits of an Icon. In 2011, the Pallant House Gallery in Chichester hosted an exhibition of their work: Frida Kahlo and Diego Rivera: Masterpieces from the Gelman Collection. In 2018, the Victoria and Albert Museum showed paintings, photographs, and clothing for the exhibition Frida Kahlo: Making Herself Up The accompanying lecture series was organised by Chloë She also contributed to the exhibition catalogue, which is still on sale.

Diego y yoFrida Kahlo and Diego Rivera were married in 1929. Their turbulent marriage and the turbulent times they lived through are the subject of the film Frida (USA, 2002). They are key figures in The Lacuna, a historical novel published in 2009 by Barbara Kingsolver and currently on the reading list of many UK Book Clubs. (In November 2021 Diego y yo (right) sold for \$35M - an auction record for Latin art.)

#### About Chloe Sayer

Freelance specialist in the art and culture of Latin America. Has lectured in the UK, Canada, Ireland, Mexico, Australia and New Zealand. Has curated exhibitions, and assisted on TV documentaries for BBC and Channel 4. Has made collections in Mexico and Belize for the British Museum, and is Research Associate in the Department of World Cultures at the Royal Ontario Museum. In 2016 she was awarded the prestigious Ohtli medal by the Mexican government for her longstanding commitment to Mexican culture. Her many publications include Mexican Textiles (British Museum Press, 1990), Arts and Crafts of Mexico (Thames & Hudson, 1990), Focus on Aztecs and Incas (Watts Books, 1995), The Incas - The Ancient World (Wayland, 1998), Textiles from Mexico (British Museum Press, 2002), and Mexico: Clothing and Culture (Royal Ontario Museum, 2015). Has also published articles in travel guides, newspapers and magazines.
