



What roses really mean and why we give roses on Valentine's Day



In Victorian England, women's roles in society were limited by custom and norms. Within those structures, learning the language of flowers, the notion that each and every flower has its own meaning was one activity deemed domestically appropriate for them. And for ladies in that situation, its communicative possibilities also held an appeal that other domestic arts lacked; "the possibility that some women sought methods of covert communication and expression exists," Mary Brooks wrote in "Silent Needles, Speaking Flowers." The early popularization of this practice is credited to Lady Mary Wortley Montagu, the wife of a British ambassador to Turkey in the 18th century. Enthralled by a Turkish version of flower language, Lady Montagu wrote a series of letters home to England in 1716. She described the Turkish tradition as a way of assigning meaning to objects in order to send secret love letters. Montagu's letters, published in 1763, wrote of her perceptions of this practice: "There is no colour, no flower, no weed, no fruit, herb, pebble, or feather that has not a verse belonging to it: and you may quarrel, reproach, or send letters of

passion, friendship, without ever inking your fingers," she wrote.
But the Lady was actually incorrect in her interpretation As Beverly Seaton explains in The Language of

Flowers: a History,



the Turkish flower language sélam (which means "hello" in Arabic) did not function the way Montagu understood. In sélam, "the significance of the objects is not symbolic, but relates to words that rhyme with the object's name," Seaton explained. There was no sentimentality surrounding the flowers themselves.

In spite of Montagu's misunderstanding, word of the concept spread. Langage des fleurs, a dictionary for the language of flowers by Charlotte de Latour, was published in France in 1819, a century after Montagu's discovery. Nine editions of the English translation of the book, which alphabetically defined each flower, were printed within three decades of its publication, according to The Culture of Flowers by Jack Goody. De Latour's translated Language of Flowers covered most popular flowers we buy, sell and give today, from the mistletoe's importance during Christmas to the musk rose's symbolization of "capricious beauty."

In de Latour's chapter on the rose, the flower is not only defined as meaning "love," but the plant itself is

romanticized. "Who that ever could sing has not sung the Rose! The poets have not exaggerated its beauty, or completed its panegyric," she wrote. Not that that stopped de Latour from attempting to add to the panegyric of the rose herself: "Nature seems to have exhausted all her skill in the freshness, the beauty of form, the fragrance, the delicate colour, and the gracefulness which she has bestowed upon the Rose," she wrote.

Throughout the 19th century, books about the language of flowers circulated throughout England. Prolific illustrator Kate Greenaway's book, published in 1884, accompanies Latour's definitions with drawings for children.

The trend took on a life of its own, spurring stories and poetry that pointed to the flower's lasting emotional power. Charlotte Elizabeth's Floral biography: or, Chapters on flowers (1848) was a meditation on the way the author's life could be categorized, in a way, by experiences with flowers. Elizabeth wrote of the way a rose brought her happiness during one New Year's celebration: "I know that, when our glasses were replenished, with orange wine, to drink a happy new-year all round, the Christmas

rose which I held in my hand formed a portion of my new-year's happiness, by no means inconsiderable." Sales of roses skyrocketed. Botanists throughout Victorian



England and France worked to develop new kinds of roses in the 19th century, says Stephen Scanniello, curator of the Peggy Rockefeller Rose Garden at the New York Botanical Garden. In the northeastern U.S., the American Beauty rose was spreading. This cultivar was reportedly shipped from New Jersey to Queen Victoria herself, Scanniello tells TIME. The American Beauty, dubbed the "millionaire's rose" for its expensive price point in the 1800s, is the variety of the flower we often purchase and send for Valentine's Day today. Though it had been the Victorians who ingrained the rose's meaning into modern society, they weren't the first in history to assign symbolic meaning to objects found in nature. The language of flowers is merely one aspect of this larger phenomenon, says Amy King, an associate professor of English at St. John's University. "It's part of a yearning, I believe, to give language to the phenomenal world," King told TIME in an email. Today, this desire has not gone to the wayside. Though most of us are not fluent in the language of flowers, we still blush when we're sent a bouquet of roses.

To match a feeling of desire, the striking aesthetic beauty of the flower makes it an obvious choice, King posits: "Parts of nature that can so readily arrest our mental

attention, one might argue, are particularly suited to the expression of romance." Beyond this fascination, the colour of the traditional rose may play an important role in its enduring relationship with love, argues Arielle Eckstut, the author of The Secret Language of

Colour. A blush brings redness to the face in moments of attraction and desire. Even Greeks and Romans between the 4th and 5th Century BC, Scanniello explains, adorned themselves in rose garlands during wedding ceremonies. But can we blame them? "The beauty of flowers," Scanniello says, "definately has created all the attention that the rose gets."

As the initial excitement of the new year begins to settle, February offers a quieter, more introspective time to assess where you are and where you want to be. For many, the post-holiday period can bring a sense of relief; but also, it can bring a moment of clarity about personal habits, including alcohol consumption.

After the festivities of December and January, it's easy to slip into old patterns, especially when social settings continue to revolve around drinking. The temptation to maintain a "party mindset" can linger, and the weight of alcohol-related regrets or uncomfortable situations may only become more apparent when things calm down.

"My name is Yasmine. I am 77 years old. Nothing could stop me drinking. My rock bottom came when I was arrested for drink-driving, and I had to appear in court. Can you imagine the shame! That's when I knew I had to do something. I called the AA helpline, I didn't know what to expect, but I felt relieved. "Stop fighting it. There was an answer to my problem. Give AA a try"

That was almost 44 years ago. Life has been good and bad; I have experienced a lot in my recovery. To a

newcomer I would say: Stop fighting it. Give AA a try."

Are you finding it hard to stop now the holidays are behind you? Do you find yourself reaching for a drink even on days you swore you wouldn't? Do you experience moments of regret over your drinking? Have friends or family expressed concern about your alcohol use?

If any of this rings true, it's important to remember that you are not alone. For many, the idea of living without alcohol may seem daunting. Questions about how to socialise, relax, or even enjoy life without it are common.

Alcoholics Anonymous (AA) is one of the most effective resources for those seeking support. AA provides a welcoming, non-judgmental space where individuals can share their experiences, draw strength from one another, and discover that a life free from alcohol is not just possible; it can be incredibly rewarding.

Here, two members of AA share their stories of transformation:

"I am Jake, 32 years old. My dad was an alcoholic. He drank a lot when I was growing up. He died when he was 48 with heart, kidney and liver failure due to alcoholism. My rock bottom was an emotional one. I still had a job; I still had a relationship, but I was completely broken and soul-destroyed on the inside. I didn't want to drink anymore but I just couldn't stop.

Life now is amazing. Life events still happen but the difference is now I can

handle any situation no matter what it is, and I don't feel the urge or the need to

drink alcohol. If you are struggling with alcohol I would say: Please just ask for help. Reach out to someone in AA or call the helpline. You wouldn't believe how this can change your life."



There are meetings of Alcoholics Anonymous, with friendly people who will understand, held daily, throughout the Costa del Sol. Meetings are free to attend, and anyone who thinks they may have a problem with alcohol is welcome.

9th February 1964. Seventy-three million Americans tuned into the Ed Sullivan Show to watch four young men from Liverpool appear for the very first time – The Beatles. The musical group had grown out of a shared enthusiasm for American rock and roll.



11th February 1975. Margaret Thatcher became the first female leader of a major political party in the UK, as leader of the British Conservative Party. A few years later in 1979, Thatcher also became the first female prime minister of Britain, serving until 1990. Due to her uncompromising politics and leadership style, Thatcher became known as the 'Iron Lady'.



11th February 1990. Nelson Mandela was released from Victor Verster prison after being jailed for 27 years, aged 71. He was imprisoned for attempting to overthrow South Africa's apartheid rule. Four years after his release, he was inaugurated as South Africa's first democratically elected president. Mandela served one term as president before focusing on his work for the Nelson Mandela Children's Fund, the Nelson Mandela Foundation, and the Nelson Mandela Rhodes Foundation. Nelson Mandela died in 2013 and is remembered for his relentless fight for equality, and his work to combat poverty, AIDS, and HIV.

12th February 1554. At just 16 years old, Lady Jane Grey was beheaded at the Tower of London. Ruling for just nine days, Jane Grey is remembered in British history as the monarch with the shortest reign. Despite being fifth in line to the throne after the death of her cousin King Edward VI, Lady Jane was proclaimed Queen in an unsuccessful bid to prevent the accession of Catholic Mary Tudor.

Dog Training with Karen

When it comes to dog training, it's important to get started early and be consistent. Training your dog isn't just about ensuring they do what you tell them to. Training can help make life healthier, happier and safer for your pet.

Follow these 5 golden rules to make dog training easy and fun.

1. Go at your dog's pace

You might think blocking out a 2-hour training session is the best way to train a dog quickly, but, just like humans, canines can only concentrate for so long. Training pushes your dog's mental abilities and it can be exhausting.

Break your trick and obedience training into short, regular sessions rather than pushing your dog for hours at a time. Too long a session and they may get tired, frustrated, bored and overwhelmed. Most importantly, they won't learn as efficiently.

Around 15 to 20 minutes every day broken into 5 minute blocks is plenty for young puppies, while a block of 15 to 20 minutes maximum in a day is enough for older dogs. It can be a good idea to finish up each training session practicing a

each training session practicing a command your dog already knows, so they can end on a positive note.

2. Be consistent and patient Don't give up on your dog just because they don't learn a new trick the first time around. Dogs learn at different speeds. If your dog is taking longer than you'd expect to pick up a new trick or behaviour, be patient and keep trying. Training is an ongoing practice that will require consistent effort from you every day. It's also essential to stay consistent with the commands or cues you're teaching your dog. If you sometimes tell them to 'lie down' and at other times tell them to 'get down off the sofa, this will confuse them. Pick one cue and stick to it. Similarly, don't use the same command or cue for different actions and make sure

everyone in the household is using the same cues too.

3. Use (good) rewards

All training should be rewards-based. And the more your dog values the reward you give them during training, the more likely they are to repeat that behaviour.

For many dogs, this means special food treats, such as small pieces of cheese or meat. Just be sure to save these treats for dog training so they maintain their value.

If your dog isn't motivated by food you can use praise, affection or playtime as the reward for a job well done. Even a good belly scratch will be enough if that's what your dog loves the most.

4. Set your dog up for success

You want your dog to succeed, so give them the best chance by making it easy for them to get it right. This means minimising distractions, especially when they're learning a new trick or command. Choose a quiet room in your house, without other people or animals, traffic noises or interesting smells to capture their attention. Make sure you (and the reward) are the most interesting things available during your session, so their attention doesn't wander.

5. Never punish

Training that involves punishing your dog for unwanted behaviour is not a good idea, and something that we at Dog School Nerja strongly oppose. Studies show that dog training



techniques such as this are stressful for dogs, and can cause more problems than they are trying to fix. You also run the risk of accidentally reinforcing unwanted behaviour. If your dog is barking excessively because they want attention and you yell at them to stop, you're giving them the outcome they wanted because any attention is better than no attention. So, they're likely to keep on barking. It's far more effective to reward them when they're quiet and simply ignore the barking.



Serves:- 2

Ingredients:-

- 1 tbsp unsalted butter
- 1/2 tbsp extra-virgin olive oil
- 4 (3-ounce) beef tenderloin medallions, pounded 3/4-inch thick Kosher salt

Freshly ground black pepper

- 1 small shallot, minced
- 1 garlic clove, minced
- 1/4 pound button mushrooms, sliced
- 1/4 cup brandy
- 2 tsp Dijon mustard
- 1/4 cup heavy cream
- 2 tsp Worcestershire sauce
- 1 tbsp finely chopped scallions
- 1 tsp finely chopped fresh flat-leaf parsley

Hot sauce, such as Tabasco



Preparation:-

In a large skillet, melt butter with olive oil. Season meat with salt and pepper to taste and cook over high heat until lightly browned on the bottom, about 1 minute. Turn medallions and cook for 45 seconds longer, then



transfer to a plate and tent with foil.

Add shallot and garlic to skillet and cook over moderate heat, stirring, until fragrant, about 20 seconds. Add mushrooms, season with salt and pepper to taste, and cook until softened, about 2 minutes.

Remove pan from heat, add Cognac, and carefully ignite it with a long match.

When flames die down, add mustard and cream and stir over moderate heat for 1 minute.

Whisk the Worcestershire sauce, scallions, and parsley; season with salt, pepper, and hot sauce to taste.

Add meat and any accumulated juices to saucepan and turn to coat. Simmer until heated through, about 1 minute. Transfer meat to plates, spoon sauce on top, and serve.



Panna Cotta

Panna Cotta

Serves:- 6

Ingredients:-

- 1 (1/4oz.) packet unflavoured gelatine
- 1 1/4 cups half-and-half, divided
- 1/2 cup granulated sugar
- 1/4 tsp. kosher salt
- 1 3/4 cups heavy cream
- 1 1/2 tsp. vanilla bean paste
- 1 cup seedless raspberry jam
- 2 tbsp orange liqueur or fresh orange juice
- Fresh raspberries, to serve

Preparation:-

In a small bowl, sprinkle the gelatine over ¼ cup of the half-and-half. Allow the gelatien to soften for 10 minutes. In a medium saucepan, combine the remaining 1 cup of half and half, sugar, and salt. Whisk the mixture over medium-low heat until steaming. Add the gelatine and continue to whisk, careful not to boil the mixture, until the gelatine and sugar are dissolved.

Remove the mixture from the heat and whisk in the heavy cream and vanilla bean paste.

Place 6 (6oz.) ramekins on a baking sheet. Divide the cream mixture among the ramekins, using a ladle or spoon so that the vanilla bean paste is evenly distributed. Place a large sheet of plastic wrap over the baking sheet, careful not to let the plastic touch the cream.

Refrigerate for 6 hours or overnight.

In a medium microwave safe bowl or glass measuring cup, combine the raspberry jam, 3 tablespoons of water, and orange liqueur or orange juice. Microwave in 10 second

increments until smooth and well combined. Allow to cool before using.

Fill a dish with hot water. Using a small knife, loosen the top edges of the panna cotta from the ramekin, careful not to cut into the custard. Dip the ramekin up to its rim into the bowl of water for about 3 seconds. Invert onto a serving plate.

To serve: Spoon the raspberry mixture over each serving of panna cotta. Top with fresh raspberries. Serve immediately.



Eclair Cake

Eclair Cake

Serves:- 12 to 16

Ingredients:-

- 3 cups heavy whipping cream, divided
- 1 (14oz.) can sweetened condensed milk, divided
- 3 cups whole milk
- 2 (3.4oz.) boxes instant vanilla pudding mix
- 2 tsp vanilla bean paste
- 1 (14.4oz.) box graham crackers
- 8 oz. semisweet chocolate bars, finely chopped

Preparation:-

In a large bowl, use a hand mixer to whip together 2 cups of the heavy whipping cream and 1/3 cup of the sweetened condensed milk on high, beating until firm peaks form. In another large bowl, whisk together the milk, pudding mixes, vanilla bean paste, and the remaining sweetened condensed milk. Fold the whipped cream into the pudding mixture in 3 additions.

In a 13 by 9 inch glass baking dish, place a layer of graham crackers, breaking up crackers as needed to fill in any gaps. Spread half of the pudding mixture in an even layer on top of the graham crackers. Add another layer of graham crackers. Top with the remaining pudding mixture. Top with a final layer of graham crackers, cover, and refrigerate until chilled, 30 minutes.

Place the chocolate in a medium heatproof bowl. In a large glass measuring cup or another medium bowl, microwave the remaining 1 cup of heavy whipping cream until steaming, 45 seconds to 1 minute. Immediately pour the warm cream over the chocolate and allow to sit for 1 minute before whisking until smooth.

Pour the ganache over the chilled cake, smoothing with a spatula. Using a spoon, create a swooping effect in the chocolate, if desired. Cover and refrigerate until chilled and set, at least 4 hours or overnight.

Smoked Salmon & Shrimp Salad

Serves:- 4

Ingredients:-

4 slices smoked salmon 20 shrimp cooked, peeled with tails in tack 3 Cups mixed salad greens Juice from 2 limes divided Grated lime zest from 2 limes divided 2 tbsp honey

4 tbsp Olive Oil Salt and pepper to taste 1 ½ tsp fresh ground ginger 1/2 cup Greek yogurt

Preparation:-

First make the vinaigrette dressing by adding the olive oil, lime juice, honey, ginger, grated lime zest and olive oil in a medium bowl.

Whisk together until all

ingredients are combined. Set aside.

In a small bowl add the Greek yogurt, 1 teaspoon of lime juice and 1 teaspoon of lime zest. Stir to combine and set aside.


Place a piece of smoked salmon on each plate. Arrange around the outside of the salmon 5 shrimps on each plate. To make it look pretty you can arrange them so that one tail is facing in and the other out, in alternating order around the salmon. Add about a teaspoon of the yogurt dressing in the middle of each piece of salmon. In a large bowl, add the salad leaves and pour over dressing and coat well. Then serve a small amount of salad leaves over the salmon. Do this for each plate until they are all done. You should now have dressing left in your bowl. Drizzle a little over each plate and top with a tiny amount of the leftover Greek yogurt mixture. Serve immediately.



• Bring your right arm toward your chest and hold your elbow with your left hand, gently pushing toward the opposite shoulder. Hold for 10-15 seconds and repeat with the other arm. This exercise helps reduce tension in the shoulders and improve mobility.

Lower back stretch:

• Lie on your back with your knees bent and feet flat on the floor. Bring one knee toward your chest and gently hug it. Hold for 10-15 seconds and switch legs. Repeat 3-5 times with each leg to reduce stiffness in the lower back.

Leg raises:

• Lie on your side and raise your top leg, keeping it straight. Slowly lower and repeat 10 times. Switch sides and do the exercise with the other leg. This movement strengthens the muscles in your legs and reduces pressure on your joints.

Gentle marching in place:

• Stand upright and lift your knees alternately as if you were marching in place. Perform the exercise for 1-2 minutes. This exercise activates circulation and helps warm up your muscles without impacting your joints.

• Kneel on the floor and sit on your heels. Extend your arms forward and lower your torso until your forehead touches the floor. Hold this position for 20-30 seconds. This stretch is ideal for relieving tension in your back and neck.

To practice it:

OBESITY - The on going struggle!

In the ongoing struggle against obesity, individuals often find themselves grappling with an internal war—a complex battle waged within the recesses of their minds. Every day, people fight a complex battle within their minds, wrestling with an unrelenting hunger after a hearty meal, succumbing to cravings for fried chicken or gummy bears.

These personal narratives echo the challenges faced by a substantial portion of adults grappling with obesity—a condition we, in the medical field, have come to recognize as a disease. While debates persist, encompassing concerns about cost, side effects, and the potential to divert focus from lifestyle changes, there's a resounding agreement among my peers—a critical organ has been overlooked in our battle against obesity, and that organ is the brain.

Obesity



As a doctor, I increasingly recognize that obesity likely involves a disruption within the very machinery of the brain. Our brains, akin to ceaselessly humming machines, interpret signals from the gut, hormones, and the environment to regulate hunger, assess the impact of food, and maintain energy balance. Research unveils malfunctioning circuits and pathways in individuals with obesity—impaired dopamine receptors, disrupted gut-brain signalling, and muted responses to meals.

The question persists: What triggers these malfunctions within the intricate

network of the brain? Genetics play a role, undoubtedly, accounting for a significant portion of the variability in body mass index. However, it falls short of explaining the surge in obesity witnessed over recent decades. Enter the changing landscape of our food supply, now dominated by ultraprocessed foods constituting 60% of our diet—a significant contributing factor. These foods, laden with additives and artificial components, may disrupt the delicate balance of gut-brain signalling, leading to overconsumption.



HOSPITAL DISCHARGE -

It can be fantastic news it can also be very scary if you don't know how the system works...

A few pointers.

Plan for discharge as soon as they go in- easier if it's a planned admission. If you need equipment source it at the start (often walking frames and wheel chairs are on prescription)..

.but you have to ASK.

Discharge after an emergency admission can be much more difficult as often after getting out of bed for the first time the patient is discharged home, (even if they didn't get out of bed under their own steam!).

If you don't live alone the partner is expected to take on the caring role. (The fact that they might have chronic health problems themselves isn't factored into the hospital departure process).

The patient is discharged home (ok ,you have 3 flights of stairs and your loved one can't walk... no problem the ambulance crew will get them up there). After the initial joy of unity fades reality kicks in and the 3rd floor prison becomes a very lonely place.

26th February 1848. The Communist Manifesto pamphlet was published by two young socialists, Karl Marx and Friedrick Engels. The pamphlet advocated the abolition of all private property and a system in which workers owned all means of production, factories, land, and machinery. The Communist Manifesto predicted revolution throughout Europe, and in the 20th century the world began witnessing the rise of dictators like Vladimir Lenin, Joseph Stalin, and Mao Zedong. By 1950 nearly half of the world's population lived under Marxist governments.
