



An international operation against drug trafficking between the Italian authorities and the National Police resulted in a father and son wanted in Italy being arrested in Malaga. The events took place between August 2020 and December 2021, when both were responsible for importing, transporting and selling large quantities of narcotic substances, including cocaine, marijuana and hashish. Both were responsible for promoting, organizing, and distributing the substances from Malaga.

#### Bus driver in Ronda tested positive for cocaine.

A school bus driver carrying 12 minors on the bus tested positive for cocaine. He was also fined for lacking insurance and specific signage for schoolchildren. Officers from the Malaga Traffic Subsector reported the driver of a school bus for driving while intoxicated, the events occurred on March 14<sup>th</sup>, 2025, on the A-374 highway in the Malaga municipality of Ronda.

## Malaga home opens to help inmates reintegrate into society upon release.

Women without financial resources or support networks now have temporary shelter to help them after regaining their freedom.

It is a social integration project to help support the women and allow them to live freely and normally.

#### Málaga's third hospital.

A third hospital will be built on the parking lot of the Civil Hospital. Tenders for the construction contract and the concession for the parking lot has been published, at a cost of €607.5 million and a 75-month completion period.

The deadline for submitting bids will end in July.

#### 100 people defrauded with fake rentals.

An investigation determined that the individual posted fake rental ads for homes located in various locations across the country. He stole identities and moved €80.000 euros through mule accounts. More than 100 residents across all the Autonomous Communities were allegedly defrauded. The victims paid various amounts of money as a deposit, which the victims agreed to without warning and in haste for fear of losing the rental option due to high demand. At the time of his arrest, the man had 12 legal complaints filed by various courts throughout Spain for the investigation of similar crimes.

#### Man drowns on Fuengirola beach.

A man was rescued by two people, but emergency services were unable to revive him after. According to the callers, the man was found about 60 meters from the shore, struggling to get out of the water.

#### Police officers deliver a baby girl in a car.

Three police officers on duty in Marbella, carrying out duties related to this Citizen Security Unit in an unmarked vehicle, observed a 36 year old Ukrainian man getting out of his vehicle near a hospital, his partner about to give birth was in the car. With no time to transport her to the hospital, the National Police placed the mother in the back seat of the vehicle, as she was ready to give birth. Upon the paramedics arrival, the officers made way for the medical professionals.





## A man arrested in Malaga for masturbating on the beach

Local Police were alerted regarding a man masturbating on the beach in front of minors. The man was arrested for exposing himself and then taken to the police headquarters, where officers confirmed that he had several arrests for robbery with violence.

#### Golf buggy plunges into river.

Two men aged 29 and 46 were left injured at the Santa Clara Golf club in Marbella when their golf buggy plunged into a river. The victims were rushed to the Regional Hospital in Malaga by air ambulance. At the moment, their conditions are unknown.

#### Collision on the Costa del Sol motorway.

A multiple collision took place at La Cala del Moral on the Costa del Sol. The collision happened on the Malagabound carriageway.

#### 66.000 Airbnb rental listings in Spain to be removed.

Airbnb have been told to remove 66.000 properties by a Spanish court but Airbnb have announced plans to appeal the Spanish high court ruling. The removal of the listings is due to the properties breaching regulations for tourist accommodation.

# The rise of Social Security scams in Spain is catching people off guard.

A fresh wave of scams is going around in Spain right now it's focusing on Social Security. Thousands of people have already been caught out by this Social Security scam either by a phone call or computer message.

#### Bad parking in Spain.

Spain has laws in place to punish drivers who park across multiple spaces, and it could now become very expensive. When a vehicle is parked across two or more spaces, it can be considered a violation and lead to a fine.

The costs vary from minor offences being between €80 and €100, and serious offences could cost up to €200. If the fine is paid within 20 calendar days you are eligible for a 50% discount, but forfeit the right to dispute the ticket.

They arrived at their hotel, opposite the Museum of Huelva in the early afternoon and spent the rest of the day exploring this interesting city, with so many points of interest, including the Rio Tinto wharf, the Cathedral of Santa Iglesia de Nuestra Señora de la Merced and the 'Barrio Obrero Reina Victoria', with its Historical British style houses and the many monuments.

The following day the group visited the Rio Tinto mines with a 4 hour guided tour included. After meeting the guide, they drove out to the vast Corta Atalaya Mine and watched the workers manoeuvring the huge trucks around. They then rode on the old mining train, viewing the weird, colourful landscape and the red Rio Tinto River. Also included in the tour was a visit to the mining museum and House 21, one of the houses used by the mine workers in days gone by. There was then free time to have lunch before returning to the hotel.

On Thursday the destination for the day was Aracena where they visited La Gruta de la Maravillas (the Cave of Wonders), a network of limestone caverns with impressive rock formations that have taken centuries to form. These caves are amazing and considered one of the most amazing natural treasures of Spain. A visit to the Ham Museum and the Castle was also included for those who

still had energy left after the difficult walk in the caves. There was time to have lunch in the beautiful old square, before returning to Huelva.

On the last day there was time for an early breakfast before joining the coach to go to the beautiful Doñana National and Natural Park. Bursting with life, thanks to a season of heavy rains, this visit was the crowning glory of the trip to Huelva. The once-parched marshlands have returned to their former glory and, according to the wonderful guide, Sonya, are the best for 20 years. The bird life was spectacular with hundreds of Flamingos, Spoonbills, Storks, Red Kites, Black Kites, Owls, Terns and many more species to be seen. Lunchtime was spent in El Rocio before travelling to the Muelle de las Caravelas to climb on board the replicas of Columbus's 3 ships and visit the museum.

On Saturday morning, after a leisurely breakfast, the group returned to Torre del Mar, arriving back mid-afternoon. All agreed that this had been a wonderful trip with friendly people, a great hotel, fabulous weather and an interesting itinerary, with visits to some fantastic places. A trip to be remembered.



#### Parc Samà Historical Garden

Modernism and nature. Their inseparable relationship, guided by the master Josep Fontserè i Mestres and in collaboration with Antoni Gaudí. A place from which to understand the exceptional nature of this universal Catalan artist's work. Grottoes, walkways, and benches that evoke rocks, shells, and branches, carefully designed to be seen as if they were a landscape. This is the beginning of Modernism and Antoni Gaudí's career; it is the architecture of Parc Samà.

In 1881, Salvador Samà commissioned Josep Fontserè i Mestres to build a holiday home surrounded by gardens reminiscent of the lost island of Cuba . Parc Samà is the perfect fusion of the developer's sensitivity and the creativity of his master builder. He was a master of great works, but also of other masters. He directed and built works such as the Ciutadella Park in Barcelona with the collaboration of Antonio Gaudí. The greatest exponent of Catalan modernism participated in Parc Samà. Here he worked with wrought iron, ceramics, wood, and glass, materials that later became his raw materials. Parc Samà is the perfect fusion of sensitivity and creativity, nature, styles, and art: the best launching pad for the genius and eclectic modernism of Antoni Gaudí.

Parc Samà is a garden with memory; it is what it hides and what it tells. The life of Marquis Salvador Samà i Torrents was very dynamic, and the park reflected his political and social commitment. Parc Samà hosted visits by HM King Alfonso XIII and Queen Victoria Eugenie, and was the venue for numerous political meetings and conventions. In the 1920s, the Development Council carried out several botanical experiments, particularly trials aimed at eradicating the olive fruit fly.

#### Part 2

His passion for nature led him to become a collector of animals brought from various places. The garden owes its name to the fact that, due to his hobby, it was equipped with various pavilions and cages housing pheasants, parrots, wolves, monkeys, crocodiles, a panther, and even a bear, peacocks, Peruvian Ilamas, macaws, marabous birds, swallows, swans, ostriches, parakeets, and beautiful aquariums that completed the Parc Samà's fauna. Besides nature, Salvador Samà i Torrents's great passion was horses, and he kept magnificent specimens in his park stable. His collection of horse-drawn carriages was considered the finest in Spain. Besides being a wide variety (tilburis, landaus, covered carriages, and mourning carriages), most were made by the prestigious Binder company.

His grandson and successor, Salvador Samà i Coll, inherited his grandfather's character and virtues and became the next owner of the park. He rode horses, was attentive to detail and sociable, and had an innate aesthetic taste. He was also a great person who was loved by everyone. He inherited his grandfather's passion for aesthetics and the park. He would spend hours and hours in the garden, knew every tree, and would sit on a bench for long periods of time to see what he could improve. Salvador Samà i Coll was the first Samà to open the doors of his garden to the public, and he often chatted with tourists . He spoke German, English and French perfectly, and when he was on the veranda having a snack, he had invited visitors to join him more than once.

But Parc Samà has also witnessed the Civil War. In 1936, the park was used exclusively for military purposes. The palace and gardens were confiscated by the Cambrils Anti-

Feixist Committee, and the grounds became a Military Training Centre, where thousands of soldiers passed through and were sent to the trenches after just a few days. The sign of the quartermaster's kitchen and the entrance to the air-raid shelter can still be seen. It is estimated that at the height of the war, some 2,500 soldiers were stationed in barracks and tents scattered throughout the grounds. The machine-gun section was positioned in the Angulo Tower under the command of Captain Medrano.

In 1938, the park housed the soldiers of the "Quinta del Biberón" (Baby Bottle Regiment), who, after receiving military training for just three days, were sent to the Ebro or Segre lines. At the end of the same year, a "Hospital de Sang," or field hospital for the war wounded, was established within the grounds. The post war period brought changes, and what had been a hunting estate became a farm. Olive trees, vines, and hazelnut trees were planted. A winery and a winepress were built, where muscatel wine was produced and sold directly. More than twenty farmers worked the land.

During this new phase, Parc Samà hosted the first editions of the Cambrils International Classical Music Festival. Salvador Samà i Coll, a music lover, was the driving force behind this festival, along with Lluís Recasens, the mayor of Cambrils at the time. Salvador Samà made the garden available for concerts, which featured performances by José Carreras and Montserrat Caballé, among others. Alfonso de Fontcuberta, 7th Marquis of Marianao, received the park as a donation from his mother in 1981 and made the second major change to the park: he restructured the estate, invested in machinery, planted new trees such as almond and peach trees, and marketed the produce wholesale. He installed drip irrigation throughout the estate and for all this, he received the Deu Award from the Institut Agrícola de Catalunya as a model estate. Alfonso de Fontcuberta realized that the park had become a tourist attraction, and after a trip to California, he copied the model of visiting places with cultural and leisure attractions. Thus began the tourist visits and marketing of the park through intermediaries. In this sense, it could be said that Parc Samà was the first leisure park in Spain.



#### Holly

Holly and Star were rescued as young pups on Christmas Day a couple of years ago, when they were found by a Swedish holidaymaker who was taking a walk along the Rio Chillar in Nerja. The Costa Animal Society (CAS) was contacted for help by the Swedish lady on Boxing Day stating she would only be in town for a week and she did not know what to do with the pups. A foster home is difficult to find at normal times and with it being the holidays the local kennels were full with private customers but after a reshuffle of the schedule emergency accommodations were secured on a temporary basis. However, after the Christmas season passed and things quietened down it was decided that Holly and Star would be able to stay at the kennels on a permanent basis until new homes could be found. At the time, Holly was about 3-4 months old and she has an outgoing yet sweet personality so everyone thought she

would be rehomed fairly quickly but perhaps because of her rugged good looks, or with her being mislabelled as a Mastiff cross, she has been passed over for smaller and cuter dogs. Now that Holly is fully grown her breed has been reevaluated and CAS now thinks she is a large version of a Teckle/Dachshund as she has relatively short legs. Holly is slightly more muscular than her sister and is a bit darker in colour. She has been spayed, is in very good health and is fully vaccinated.

#### Star

At the time, Star was about 3-4 months old and she has a gregarious and friendly personality so CAS thought she had a good chance to find a new home. However, possibly because of her appearance or because she was initially determined to be a larger breed, Star has been passed over all year for smaller and cuter dogs. Now that she is an adult, it is clear that Star is more of a Teckle/Dachshund as she has relatively short legs. Star is a bit smaller than her sister but has a more determined nature. She has been spayed, is in very good health and is fully vaccinated.



# More than just a drink: Finding clarity this summer

As summer begins and the days stretch longer, many of us look forward to holidays, barbecues, and relaxed social gatherings. Warm weather and long evenings can encourage social drinking - but what if that one glass is turning into many? For some, this season can bring more than just sunshine; it can highlight a growing reliance on alcohol.

Perhaps you've found that drinking has become part of every weekend - or even every day. Maybe you've told yourself, I'll take a break, only to find yourself reaching for another drink anyway. If you feel alcohol is no longer just part of the fun - but something you need - it may be time to pause and reflect.

If this sounds familiar, you're not alone. Many people find that alcohol has slowly crept into their daily routine, only realising it's taken hold when something goes wrong - or when everything starts to fall apart.

For those ready to make a change, Alcoholics Anonymous (AA) offers a supportive, confidential space where people share their experiences and discover a path to freedom from alcohol. Here are two honest accounts from people who found a new way of life through AA:

Alice, 44, began drinking in her teens. Over time, it became a daily habit - one that took over her life.

"Hardly anyone ever said anything," she reflects.
"But I knew something was wrong. I hit my
lowest point when I passed out with a pack of
Valium in my hand. I woke up, still holding it, and
asked God what to do. The answer was clear:
stop drinking."

Her life was in chaos. "My daughter wasn't speaking to me, my husband hated me, and I was living in a rented place I'd let fall apart. Then I found a website for people trying to quit drinking, and from there I met members of AA." Alice's first meeting was online. "I didn't understand what was going on, but I stayed sober. I kept going. I found a sponsor and started working the programme. I don't know how the 12 Steps work - but they do. And they've helped me get my life back."

Mikael, 45, had a loving family, a successful career, and a happy home - but he couldn't stop drinking.

"I passed out on the kitchen floor at 11 a.m. after three gin and tonics. I woke up in bed, my wife and son crying beside me. That was the moment I knew I had to change."

Two weeks later, he walked into his first AA meeting. "I didn't know what to expect, but people were kind. They greeted me and made me feel welcome. That was all I needed." Now over a year sober, Mikael says, "Life is better - still a work in progress - but I show up for it now."

There are meetings of Alcoholics Anonymous, with friendly people who will understand, held daily throughout the Costa del Sol. Meetings are free to attend, and anyone who thinks they may have a problem with alcohol is welcome.














# Spinach and Ricotta Stuffed Mushrooms Spinach and ricotta stuffed mushrooms

Serves:- 4

#### Ingredients:-

8 large flat mushrooms, stalks removed

250g reduced-fat ricotta cheese

1/₃ cup grated Parmesan cheese

1 egg

3 cups baby spinach leaves, finely chopped

3 green shallots, finely chopped

1/4 red capsicum, finely chopped

1/4 cup chopped basil leaves

1 tsp Tuscan seasoning

2 tsp grated lemon zest

Pinch of ground pepper

Olive oil



#### Preparation:-

Preheat the oven to 180°C. Line a baking tray with baking paper. Place the mushrooms, stalk side up, on the prepared tray.

Combine the remaining ingredients, except oil, in a large bowl and season with pepper. Spoon the ricotta mixture evenly onto the mushrooms and lightly drizzle with olive oil. Cover with foil and bake for 15 minutes.

Remove foil and bake for a further 20 minutes or until mushrooms are tender. Serve.



**Apple and Cinnamon Slice** 

#### Apple and cinnamon slice

Serves:- 16

#### Ingredients:-

½ cup apple purée

⅓ cup caster sugar

2 eggs

½ cup reduced-fat natural Greek yoghurt

1 tsp ground cinnamon

1 cup wholemeal self raising flour

200g canned apple slices

#### Preparation:-

Preheat the oven to 180°C. Grease and line a 20cm x 20cm square baking tin.

Add the apple purée and sugar to a large bowl and whisk until combined. Whisk in the eggs, one at a time until combined. Add the yoghurt and cinnamon and whisk to combine. Add the flour and gently fold through until combined.

Spoon the mixture into the prepared tin. Arrange the apple slices on top. Bake for 20-25 minutes, until a skewer inserted in the centre comes out clean. Stand in tin for 10 minutes before turning out onto a wire rack to cool. Slice and serve.



Zucchini and cheese hashbrown cups

Serves:- makes 12

Ingredients:-

Olive oil

500g potatoes, peeled, grated & liquid squeezed out

2 tbsp olive oil

Pinch of salt

Freshly cracked pepper to taste

6 eggs

4 egg whites

1/4 cup reduced-fat cheddar, grated

2 zucchinis, grated & liquid squeezed out

4 spring onions, diced

1 cup frozen peas.

#### Preparation:-

Pre-heat the oven to 200°C. Liberally grease a standard 12-cup muffin tin with olive oil. In a large bowl, combine the potato and olive oil. Add a pinch of salt and pepper. Divide the mixture evenly into the muffin cups and press firmly into the bottom and up the sides to form a well. Bake for 15 to 20 minutes or until the edges turn golden. Meanwhile, in a separate bowl, whisk together the eggs. Add the cheese, zucchini, spring onion and peas and mix to combine.

Once the hash browns are cooked, remove from the oven and slowly pour the egg mixture into each cup. Return to the oven and cook for 15 minutes or until the eggs are set. Run a knife around the outside of each cup and ease them out of the tin.



#### **Blueberry and Oat Muffins**

#### Blueberry and oat muffins

Serves:- makes: 12

#### Ingredients:-

2 cups plain flour (white or wholemeal, or a mixture)

1 cup oats

<sup>2</sup>⁄₃ cup brown sugar

1 tsp baking powder

1 tsp baking soda

11/2 cups reduced-fat Greek yogurt

2 eggs, lightly beaten

50g margarine, melted, slightly cooled

1 tsp vanilla extract

#### Preparation:-

Pre-heat the oven to 180°C.

Prepare a muffin tin by greasing with margarine or spraying with oil.

Melt the margarine.

Combine flour, oats, sugar, baking powder and baking soda in a bowl and mix well.

In a second bowl, combine yogurt, eggs, margarine and vanilla. Fold the yogurt mixture into the dry mixture. Gently fold in blueberries.

Spoon mixture into muffin tin and bake for 20-25 minutes or until the top is golden and springs back when touched.





#### CAN I TREAT MY INSOMNIA WITH ACUPUNCTURE?



Insomnia is one of the most frequent sleep disturbances that currently exist. Since they affect a large part of society. We can define insomnia as the alteration or modification of sleep.

#### Tyoes of Insomnia

It can be presented in several ways:

- Problems falling asleep at bedtime. This case is the most frequent or common, and this type is called initial insomnia.
- At other times insomnia however occurs when we wake up very frequently. Also when we wake up often throughout the night. This type is called intermediate insomnia.
- · Although sometimes insomnia can also appear when we wake up very early, much earlier than we expected. This type is called terminal insomnia.

We must know that sleeping is a vital and very important function for the human being. We say this, since when we are sleeping the brain will carry out innately or naturally, a process that will allow the whole body to regenerate and recover. But when this process is affected or altered. this is when it is said that the sleep has not been restorative.

#### **Hours of Sleep**

The duration of sleep will vary from one person to another. Since, it will depend on the age. But it usually oscillates between 4 and 12 hours of sleep. For an adult, the normal and the most ideal thing is that their night sleep is about 7 to 8 hours. This sleep time will allow us, the next day, to carry out our daily or daily activities with total normality. However, on the



other hand, it must be said that an elderly person does not need so many hours of sleep. The normal thing for a 65year-old person is to sleep about 6 hours at night. These hours of sleep are totally sufficient for them since they do not carry out great activities that imply a great effort throughout the day. I mean, they don't move as much as a 40-year-old.

Another important fact to note is that insomnia appears more frequently in women than in men. They have been carried out and there is still a lot of study and research on the subject. This produces great alterations or even disorders on a mental and physical level. For this reason, when we are facing a case of insomnia it is important to know how to frame it in order to be able to carry out a successful treatment later.

#### **Insomnia Classifications**

We can perform the following classification:

- 1.- FOR ITS DURATION Which in turn is divided into:
- \* ACUTE OR TRANSIENT. This type of insomnia does not last long, only about 2 or 3 days. They appear because some type of situation is related that is not usual, such as a trip or exams. It tends to disappear the moment that specific situation that causes the patient a state of nervousness disappears. They usually do not need
- \* SHORT DURATION OR LOWER DURATION. This type of insomnia has a longer duration, usually lasting about 4 weeks. They have somewhat more important problems associated with them, such as family problems, financial problems.
- \* CHRONIC OR LONG LASTING. The duration of this type of insomnia is greater than 4 weeks. The causes that trigger this type are not known or are not very clear.
- 2.- ACCORDING TO ITS INTENSITY They are classified into:
- \* MILD. Insomnia usually appears almost every night, but quickly falls asleep again. Therefore, it does not usually alter the normal rhythm of the patient, being able to carry out his daily activities without any problem.
- \* MODERATE. Insomnia appears every night, but the time to fall asleep again is somewhat longer. Here if the power to perform daily activities is affected and even the quality of life of the patient is affected. This can lead to fatigue, irritability, and even anxiety.

#### Kids who watch lots of TV have a lower bone mass as adults

KIDS WHO WATCH a lot of television may build less bone during critical vears, and be more vulnerable to osteoporosis and bone breaks later in life as a result, a new study suggests. Children and teens followed until age 20 when bone mass is peaking - had lower bone mass at that age the more hours they had spent watching TV in childhood, researchers reported online July 4<sup>th</sup> in the Journal of Bone and Mineral Research. 'What we need to make clear is that it's not necessarily the act of watching TV that is driving the link between TV and health outcomes, but the act of sitting for long periods,' said Natalie Pearson of the School of Sport, Exercise and Health Sciences at Loughborough University in the U.K. who was not part of the new study. 'The first set of data collected on TV viewing in the current study was collected 19 years ago, and since then more and more young people have started watching TV on demand, using IPads, smart phones and apps, she told reporters by email.

For the study, led by Joanne A. McVeigh at Curtin University in Perth, Australia, the parents of more than 1,000 Australian kids reported how much TV each child watched per week at ages 5, 8, 10, 14, 17 and 20 years – though at older ages the kids started to self-report their own TV watching habits.

Researchers sorted the kids into three groups based on their TV watching patterns over time: about 20 percent watched less than 14 hours of TV per week as children and teens and were considered consistent low-level watchers, more than 40 percent watched 14 or more hours per week as children and teens and were consistent high-level watchers, and 35 percent increased from low to high levels of TV watching per week over the years.

At age 20 the participants had x-ray scans to assess bone mineral content.

The researchers accounted for height, body mass, physical activity, calcium intake, vitamin D levels, alcohol, and smoking at age 20, and still found that kids who were consistently high-level TV watchers at younger ages had lower bone mineral content than others as adults.

Immobilisation for prolonged periods of time is detrimental to bone health, said Dr. Sebastien Chastin of Glasgow Caledonian University in the U.K., who was not part of the new study.

'Sitting watching television does two things, it takes away from being active, therefore we do not get the benefit of physical activity and second



it immobilises us for prolonged period of time which we know from bed rest studies triggers physiological response that change the balance in our body chemistry that keeps our bone strong,' Chastin told reporters by email. 'Several studies have shown over the years that there is a relationship between the time we spend sitting and bone health,' he added, 'Poor bone health ultimately can .lead to osteoporosis (brittle bine disease) which effects over 200 millions women worldwide.' he said 'You can imagine that a fall on a brittle hip is more likely to result in fracture. Our bodies reach peak bone density around age 22, after which time bine density decreases over time, though we can slow the decrease by maintaining an active and healthy

lifestyle, Chastin said. 'Impact sports (not contact) are the most beneficial for bone health,' he said, citing parkour or 'free running' in particular for muscle strength, balance and coordination.

'It is often very difficult to make parents and doctors aware of the very long term health implications of sitting (at a screen or other sitting occasions such as school time, work time, travel, etc.) for long periods, as in today's society we are very interested in the immediate responses to our actions and not what will happen 20 years down the line,' Pearson said. There are practical ways to break up periods of seated screen time, like getting up during ads or while working on a computer getting up to answer the phone instead of emailing a colleague or friend, she said.



Mary and John are now in their 80's and live in a very rural area, their friends (who are now much fewer in number are also in their 80's.) Sadly there is no family support.

Mary broke her hip a few years ago, this was the time when her daughter Suzi could have come from UK to help but for a variety of reasons this didn't happen. (Nor did the orthopaedic "follow up". It was indeed lucky that Mary got her wound clips taken out.)

John is a proud man, he had always taken care of his wife. He had turned down the offer of a short stay in a residencia to get her "back on her feet" so Mary didn't walk again.... muscle wasted and Mary became chair bound. The "great friends" did not become carers.. The three nights out a week became just one to the "Tuesday night Pizza". Which ultimately became a "take away". Mary became emotionally isolated as John left her to go shopping, he went to the doctors on her behalf. Mary became very depressed ultimately John was backed into a corner and took his wife for an "in person visit" to the GP. Blood results indicated an iron deficiency (John had stopped cooking nutritious and delicious in favour of quick fix and no washing up.) Life was tough as John became ever more possessive of the love of his life.

John gave half the antidepressants and reduced the iron (to avoid constipation) but in doing so she became weaker and more confused.

He cut her drinks and she became even more confused. He cut her food (as she didn't seem to recognise what was on the plate.) Finally she fell and broke her arm.

It was hard for John to accept his wife's needs and the difference "Close Care" made but over time (taking the medication the mood lifted.)

The iron supplement and good home cooked food restored her body and she could be transferred to a wheelchair and out into the garden with potential to walk..

John didn't accept that the doctor was right but his wife smiles again but she won't eat pizza!






