All Nerja beaches equipped with PA systems

Nerja City Council is installing a new public address system on eight beaches in the municipality: Maro, Burriana, Carabeo, Calahonda, El Salón, Torrecilla, El Chucho, and El Playazo. The project, with an investment of €18,000 (VAT included), includes the installation of 13 units distributed across the various beaches and a control centre managed by the Lifeguard Service. The old equipment has been replaced on the beaches of Burriana and Torrecilla, while the system is being implemented for the first time on the rest of the beaches. Councilor for Beaches, Mari Carmen López, emphasized that "this improvement will strengthen communication and safety on the beaches, offering better service to residents and visitors."



Change of venue for Jennifer Lopez's concert

Jennifer Lopez's concert in Malaga on 11th July has been changed from Malaga to Fuengirola's Marenostrum. Those who have purchased tickets will receive new ones via email or by post, the change of venue also implies a price change due to the different configuration of the two



stages and the difference in seating capacity. The organisers have promised that those affected "will be relocated to an area of equal or higher category". Marenostrum holds 18,500 people.

Network of sports facilities on public roads to be expanded

Nerja City Council will expand its sports facilities in public spaces used by tourists with the installation of new outdoor facilities. The project is funded by the European Union through the "Next Generation" funds, within the framework of Spain's Recovery, Transformation, and Resilience Plan, as part of the "Sustainable Nerja" municipal project. The new sports facilities will be located next to the Enrique López Cuenca Stadium, as well as on the beaches of Burriana, El Chucho, and El Playazo, and on the La Torrecilla promenade.



Summer hours at the Municipal Citizen Service Offices

The Councillor for Citizen Services, Antonio López, reports that the municipal Citizen Services offices in Nerja and Maro will adopt new hours for the months of July and August.

The Nerja office, located on the ground floor of the Town Hall, will openTuesday, July 1st, Monday through Friday, from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

The Maro office will be open every Monday from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. starting Monday, June 30th.



Charity run raises cash

A €4,800 donation to AFADINE, a local association supporting families in need was raised by a charity run. The funds were raised during the 12th La Mayora Charity Run, an event which brought together dozens of participants for a day filled with sport and solidarity. They ran an eight kilometres over mixed asphalt and dirt terrain.

New unemployment office to open in Nerja

The new Oficina de Empleo will be located on the ground floor of the municipal Fernandez Olmo building, covering 387m2.

This renovation will cost €48,380.64. Mayor José Alberto Armijo promised the space will be "comfortable, modern, central and accessible," providing essential services to jobseekers in both Nerja and the nearby village of Maro.



Velez Malaga night bus service

The night bus service will be extended throughout the summer to help with the growing number of tourists through summer.

It will operate from 10.30 p.m. until 2.30 a.m. every night from July 1st to August 31st.

The service will be provided by Travelsa, part of the ALSA group, the company responsible for Velez-Malaga's municipal transport system.

Health centres summer opening hours

The Junta de Andalucía has announced changes to the opening hours of health centres and clinics across Malaga province during summer. From July 1st to September 30th, health centres in Vélez Sur, Torre del Mar, Nerja, and Torrox will remain open in the afternoons, while Vélez North, Casabermeja, Colmenar, Riogordo, and Benajarafe will operate only in the mornings. The Málaga Health District, from June 30th to September 12th, including Rincón de la Victoria, will open from 8am to 8pm, handling all non-deferrable or urgent consultations. Emergency services will be available from 8pm to 8am.

Spanish national jailed for arson attack

Spanish national Juan Francisco Sánchez Valenzuela aged 19, was given a six year sentence for starting a fire at a flat in the Mid Harbour Estate in Gibraltar which hospitalised five family members and killed their dog.

Suspected paedophile arrested

A 36 year old man faces 34 years in prison for reportedly sexually assaulting two minors and producing child pornography.

He absconding during his trial in Malaga five years ago but has since been arrested once again 5 years later. He fled after the first hearing, which had granted him provisional release.

€80,000 to finance the third phase of the Taller de la Amistad Child and Youth Care Centre

The mayor of Nerja, José Alberto Armijo, has reaffirmed the City Council's commitment to the Friendship Workshop by approving a decree that includes a municipal contribution of €80,000. This amount will be used to co-finance the construction of the third phase of the "Comprehensive Child and Youth Care Centre (TALLERTA)" project, and the necessary funds will be included in the next fiscal year's budget.

Cruise route

Cruise ship Aurora, brought nearly 2,000 passengers to the port of Motril, helping the tourism industry economy. Approximately 1,600 passengers disembarked to explore Motril and its surroundings.

Relaunch of Maro beach shuttle service

The shuttle service from Nerja to Maro beach, which will be running throughout the summer until September 15^{th} . Available every day from 10am to 8.30pm, priced at \in 3, including return.

Torrox beach safety

Saturday June 14th saw the start of the Torrox beach safety summer season program, this will continue until September 14th and start at 11.30am to 8.30pm daily. There are over 40 professionals who are supported by vehicles, boats, and drones. There are also specially trained water rescue dogs in this years safety season campaign. The operation includes a coordinator, 18 certified aquatic lifeguards with qualifications, three additional lifeguards trained as emergency medical technicians, two jet ski operators, and five healthcare professionals, including nurses and clinical assistants. The campaign also has two drones on weekends, when beaches see the highest capacity of people.

Hiring the unemployed incentives

Businesses and self employed professionals are being enticed into hiring the unemployed with cash incentives from the government.

Tivoli amusement park fire

A plot of land close to Tivoli amusement park in Benalmádena caught fire, fortunately the quick response of the emergency services prevented it from spreading. The fire was located close to the roller coaster at Tivoli amusement park.

Aldi opens new supermarket in Vélez Málaga

The German chain supermarket opened it's doors in Vélez-Málaga on Wednesday 25th June. This is the third Aldi supermarket in Vélez Málaga, it is located on Avenida Rey Juan Carlos I, on the Pañoleta industrial estate and opposite the existing Lidl store. Aldi has more than 30 supermarkets in Malaga province. Most of the products sold in Aldi supermarkets are ownbrand products, which enables the company to maintain low prices with high quality standards.

Two hundred new parking spaces created for summer

Rincón de la Victoria town hall on the eastern Costa del Sol has created a new public parking area with capacity for 200 vehicles in the centre of Torre de Benagalbón to help witrh the influx of people during the summer.

Costa del Sol beach

A beach on the Costa del Sol has been voted one of the best in Europe, this beach is located in Nerja. It is located near the Balcón de Europa with stunning views of the Mediterranean Sea". It is a 120-metre-long U-shaped cove, which is very well equipped with restaurants and has an original stone promenade.

Measels cases confirmed on the eastern Costa del Sol

There are a 50 cases in the Málaga province this includes two children in Torrox. Andalusian regional government's health and consumer affairs department confirmed 88 cases during this year so far.

Fuengirolas Pride manifesto

Fuengirola held an event on Friday 27th June that included the reading of a manifesto and a roundtable discussion under the theme 'equal in diversity'. This service offers psychological support, legal information, health advice and support for parents during the acceptance processes, among other things.

Trump threatens Spain: 'We're going to make them pay twice as much'

Spain is the only country rejecting the demand to increase defense spending to 5%. The U.S. president announced that, as retaliation for Spain's position at the NATO summit, he will double the planned tariffs on the country:

"They're going to pay, they'll pay more money this way." They're the only country that won't pay the full, they want to stay at 2%."

He added that Spain's economy is "doing very well, and that economy could be blown right out of the water with something bad happening."

invasive snake that's already on 90% of the island The rapidly advancing predator is a good swimmer and has also colonized Formentera and satellite islets in the Mediterranean. Scientists warn other micromammals that control the insect population are also disappearing.

Montgat, the Spanish town stripped of beaches and income

Climate change has swallowed beaches in the Barcelona municipality, which has lost €1 million a year since the pandemic due to the lack of tourists. Montgat, a town of 12,600 inhabitants located less than nine miles (14 km) from Barcelona, has become a prime example of the impact of climate change on the Catalan coast.

Inside Spain's slaughterhouse of horrors

Five people have been arrested in an operation targeting livestock farms, industrial warehouses, and illegal facilities in Ávila, Toledo, and Madrid that were sending untraceable meat to restaurants. In the slaughterhouse, the place was piled high with more than 200 sick, dying, and dead goats and sheep, surrounded by filth, severed animal heads, and rats..

Keep Cool: How to Manage Your Dog in the Heat of Summer From the Team at Dog School Nerja

Top Tips for Keeping Your Dog Safe in the Heat

1. Rethink Walk Times Avoid walking your dog during the hottest parts of the day. Early morning and late evening are the safest times for exercise. Before stepping out, test the pavement with your hand—if it's too hot for you, it's too hot for your dog's paws.

2. Offer Plenty of Shade and Water Make sure your dog has constant access to fresh, cool water and shaded areas. This applies both at home and when you're out and about. Adding ice cubes to their water bowl can be a fun and effective way to help them stay cool.

3. Cut Back on Intense Exercise Summer is not the time for highenergy ball games or long runs. Instead, try low-intensity enrichment activities like scent games, puzzle toys, or frozen treat-dispensing toys to keep their minds active without risking overheating.

4. Never Leave Dogs in Cars Even with the windows cracked, a parked car can become a furnace within minutes. Temperatures can rise to dangerous levels extremely quickly, putting your dog at serious risk. It's simply not worth the gamble.

5. Keep Them Groomed (But Not Shaved!)

Regular grooming helps remove excess fur and reduces overheating, but don't shave double-coated breeds—these coats are designed to protect against both heat and sunburn.

Not just holiday habits: When drinking on the Costa becomes something more

Many people move to the Costa del Sol seeking sunshine, freedom and a slower pace of life. It can feel like an endless holiday, meals out, late nights, beers by the beach, wine at lunch, and drinks well into the evening. With the sun shining and social life in full swing, it's easy to slip into a pattern of drinking daily.

But for some, what starts as a holiday lifestyle quickly becomes something more; a growing dependence on alcohol that's hard to recognise, let alone break free from.

Perhaps you've started drinking earlier in the day or need more than just one to feel relaxed. Maybe you're telling yourself you'll cut back tomorrow, only to find you can't. If that sounds familiar, you are not alone and there is a way out.

Alcoholics Anonymous (AA) offers a safe, confidential space where people struggling with alcohol can share honestly and begin to recover. Here are two real stories of people who found help through AA:

I no longer feel alone; and I'm finally learning to love myself.

At 55, Daniel was drinking daily; starting in the morning and continuing until he blacked out.

"I felt suicidal all the time. I was still working, but I was barely holding it together. Then one night, after a conversation about past drug use, things took a turn. I had a complete emotional breakdown and knew I couldn't go on."

He'd been in and out of AA since he was 25. "I never really got it until I hit rock bottom. This time

I got a sponsor, started working the Steps, went to meetings, and did service. I've now been sober for over a year."

"I'm not religious at all, but I've found a higher power that makes sense to me. Some days I still struggle, but now I've got the tools to deal with it. I'm not alone anymore."

This programme works if you work it.

Sophie, also 55, had used alcohol, drugs, and relationships to escape since her teens.

"I had many rock bottoms, especially with bipolar. I even tried to end my life before I was 21. But when I got pregnant with my first child, I knew I had to stop."

She'd gone to her first AA meeting in her twenties but wasn't ready. After many relapses, she returned and embraced the programme.

"I've done the Steps over 13 times now. They've changed my life. I believe every child should be taught them at school, it's a way of life. I don't care what you call your higher power, but you need one. This programme saved me."

There are meetings of Alcoholics Anonymous, with friendly people who will understand, held daily throughout the Costa del Sol. Meetings are free to attend, and anyone who thinks they may have a problem with alcohol is welcome.

Ingredients:-

6 small mixed peppers (120gm each), pierced 80 ml extra-virgin olive oil Parsley leaves, to serve

Preparation:-

Preheat a lightly greased barbecue to high. To cook peppers, grill, turning frequently until charred, softened and cooked through (12-15 minutes). Transfer to a heatproof bowl, cover with foil and stand at room temperature for 1 hour for skins to loosen. Remove skins, taking care not to break peppers; and discard.

Make a small incision in side of each pepper and carefully scrape out seeds; discard seeds.

Serves:-4

Ingredients:-

800 gm skinless chicken breast, cut into thin slices, or chicken thigh cut into 2cm pieces
3 tsp finely grated ginger
2 tsp finely grated turmeric
2 garlic cloves, finely grated
2 tbsp light soy sauce
1 tbsp peanut oil, for drizzling
Coconut milk, for brushing
Lime wedges or charred lime wedges, for squeezing
Mint leaves, to serve

Quick satay sauce 120 gm crunchy peanut butter 2 tbsp tamarind extract 1 tbsp light soy sauce 2 tbsp honey 1 small red chilli, finely chopped Coarsely crushed roasted unsalted peanuts, to serve

Preparation:-

Preheat a barbecue to medium-high. Combine chicken, ginger, turmeric, garlic and soy sauce in a bowl, season with sea salt and toss to coat. Thread chicken onto 12 skewers, folding pieces back on themselves if necessary. Drizzle with oil and grill, brushing with coconut milk and turning occasionally, until charred and cooked through (5-6 minutes).

Meanwhile, for satay sauce, combine ingredients in a bowl (add chilli to taste) and season to taste. Transfer to a small serving bowl and top with roasted peanuts. Squeeze lime over chicken skewers, top with mint and serve with satay sauce.

Makes:- 14

Ingredients:-

- 1 kg boneless lamb leg, cut into 2cm pieces
- 100 gm natural yoghurt
- 2 tbsp tomato paste
- 1 tsp chilli powder
- 1 tsp ground coriander seeds



¹/₂ tsp ground turmeric $\frac{1}{2}$ tsp ground cumin 1 garlic clove, crushed Melted ghee, for brushing Small green chillies, to serve Diced red onion tossed in lime juice, to serve Lime wedges, to serve Mint yogurt 250 gm natural yogurt ¹/₃ cup (loosely packed) mint, plus extra coarsely chopped to serve

Preparation:-

Preheat a barbecue to high. Combine lamb, yogurt, tomato paste, spices and garlic in a bowl and season well to taste. Thread lamb onto 14 skewers, and grill, turning and brushing with ghee occasionally, until charred and cooked through (6-8 minutes).

For mint yogurt, blend ingredients in a food processor until smooth.

Season lamb skewers with salt to taste and serve with chillies, red onion, lime wedges and mint yogurt topped with chopped mint.

Serves:-4

Ingredients:-

4 large baby octopus, cleaned, tentacles separated 1¹/₂ tsp paprika 1 garlic clove ¹/₂ tsp finely crushed fennel seeds Lemon juice, to serve ¹/₂ cup chopped dill, to serve

Tomato salad 6 tomatoes, cut into wedges 12 kalamata olives, pitted and halved 3/4 small white onion, diced 1 cucumber, peeled and diced 1/2 cup basil leaves 2 tbsp white wine vinegar (or to taste) 60 ml (1/4 cup) extra-virgin olive oil, plus extra to serve Crumbled feta, to serve

Preparation:-

Preheat a barbecue to high. Combine octopus with paprika, garlic and fennel seeds in a bowl and season with salt flakes to taste.

For tomato salad, combine ingredients in a bowl. Season to taste, transfer to a platter and top with feta.

Add octopus to barbecue and char-grill, turning once, until just cooked and charred (1-2 minutes) Transfer octopus to a plate, drizzle over oil and squeeze over lemon to taste, then scatter with dill. Serve with tomato salad on the side.

Charred prawns on skewers with lime

Serves:-20

Ingredients:-1 tsp pepper berries



Charred Prawns on Skewers with Lime

60 gm light palm sugar $60 \text{ ml} (\frac{1}{4} \text{ cup}) \text{ fish sauce}$ 20 medium uncooked prawns, heads and tails removed, cleaned Macadamia oil, for brushing 1 finger lime, halved Juice of 2 limes, plus wedges to serve Coriander sprigs, to serve

Preparation:-

Crush pepper berries with a mortar and pestle, then stir in palm sugar and fish sauce until sugar dissolves. Thread prawns onto skewers through the centre length ways, then brush lightly with the pepper berry mixture and a little macadamia oil. Refrigerate until required. Heat a barbecue and grill prawns, turning occasionally, until opaque and just cooked (2-3 minutes). Squeeze finger lime and lime juice over prawns.

Season to taste with sea salt flakes, scatter with coriander and serve with lime wedges.

treatment to be totally effective we have to take into account several factors:

1.- We must do a good, in-depth study of all the symptoms that the patient presents.

2.- Once all the symptoms have been correctly identified, with this what we are going to do is make a good diagnosis.

3.- If these two previous points have been carried out very exhaustively, it will lead us to a correct and successful treatment. In this case of insomnia, a part of the treatment will be focused on mitigating or softening stress, as well as balancing or restoring energy.

singing in a choir, or simply listening to favorite tunes, the benefits of musical engagement are manifold.

Furthermore, the study underscores the significance of lifelong musical experiences, with nearly 90% of participants reporting some form of musical engagement, past or present. This highlights the widespread appeal and accessibility of music as a means of promoting cognitive health across the lifespan.

As we strive to optimize health outcomes for our patients, it is essential to recognize the multifaceted nature of well-being and explore innovative approaches to holistic care. By embracing the therapeutic potential of music, we can tap into a

4. Is the person suffering from constipation with over flow?. This situation needs "nurse input".

- 5. Fluid intake. (It is amazing how people believe that cutting fluid will reduce incontinence whereby it does exactly the opposite).
- 6. Use of pelvic floor exercises.

7. Use of well timed laxatives.

8. Diet review.

9. Effective use of "natural" aids eg. prebiotics and cranberry juice.

- 10. Consider the latest research and eliminate caffeine.
- 11. Also consider underlying medical conditions.
